Getting to Red Rock:

Ibex, UT (Bouldering/Sport)

SPORT/BOULDERING

Getting there:

Ibex is literally in the middle of nowhere, but damn it's cool. Pretty much head south till you get near Nephi, then head west. It's about 2.5-3 hrs away, but totally worth the drive. Once you hit the dirt road, you should be able to see massive stone towers to your right, drive across the salt flats and park anywhere that looks good.

This pin takes you straight to the towers and Red Monster Boulder:

THE DEETS:

Getting to Rifle:

Weekends it's smart to pay the \$5 per

day, there is a kiosk at the entrance and by the campsites, cash only

- No service anywhere in the canyon or camping
- Closest service is by the reservoir as you head towards Rifle (the town)

Water

- There is no water source in the canyon
- There is a river to jump in, but no clean water
- Please buy or fill up in Rifle!!
